

Dress Code Policy

While working, ESA employees need to adhere to the following dress code:

- 1.) No open toed sandals or shoes shoes should have closed toes and sufficient support or safety measures for standard duties.
- 2.) Baseball caps or hats should not be worn inside. While on shift at the complex and/or completing duties outside, hats are acceptable.
- 3.) Jeans or sports apparel (not sweats) is acceptable. Building attendants or anyone working in the kitchen should have full length legwear, not shorts.
- 4.) Clothing needs to be clean and in reasonable condition (not torn).
- 5.) Clothing with inappropriate or offensive logos will not be tolerated.
- 6.) While on shift, employees need to wear articles that identify them as Edmonton Soccer Association Facilities staff (i.e. green vests and nametags).

Failure to adhere to the policy may result in staff being asked to change/remove offending articles, sent home, or written up.
